



1. What is the AeU-ASAIHL Postgraduate Fellowship (AAPF)?

The AAPF is a short-term research residency programme designed to support PhD-level researchers from ASAIHL member institutions. It aims to foster international collaboration, strengthen research capabilities, and contribute to regional development through targeted academic projects at Asia e University (AeU), Malaysia.

2. Who is eligible to apply?

Applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled in a PhD programme at an ASAIHL member institution.
- Have a well-defined research proposal relevant to AeU's areas of interest.
- Alternatively, be nominated by a research supervisor engaged in ASAIHL collaborative research.

3. What is the duration of the fellowship?

The residency lasts between 2 to 4 weeks, depending on the scope and nature of the research project.

4. What is the value of the fellowship?

Each fellowship is valued at RM7,000, which is intended to cover:

- Accommodation
- Local transportation
- Basic living expenses during the stay in Malaysia

5. Will I continue to receive my salary from my home university during the fellowship?

Yes. Since the trip is considered a service rendered to your university, you will continue to receive your regular salary from your home institution.

6. Who pays for travel expenses?

AeU will cover return economy-class airfare for the selected Fellow.

7. Is accommodation arranged or reimbursed?

Yes. Accommodation will either be:

- Arranged by AeU, or
- Reimbursed as an equivalent allowance included within the range approved by AeU.

8. Is medical care provided?

Yes. AeU will facilitate affordable medical care during the Fellow's stay in Malaysia.

9. How many fellowships are awarded each year?

AeU will award up to three (3) fellowships annually, depending on available funding and the quality of applications received.

10. What research areas are supported?

The research areas will be:

- Artificial Intelligence
- Microcredentials
- Teacher training using new pedagogies
- Chatbots
- Adaptive LMS

11. How do I apply?

Application procedures will be announced by the ASAIHL Malaysia Secretariat or AeU.

Typically, you will need to submit:

- A completed application form
- A research proposal
- A letter of endorsement from your supervisor or institution

12. What are the selection criteria?

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Relevance and impact of the proposed research
- Feasibility within the short-term residency period
- Potential for collaboration and knowledge-sharing
- Endorsement from your academic supervisor or institution

13. Can I bring family members with me?

The fellowship does not cover additional expenses for family members. Any arrangements for dependents must be made personally by the Fellow.

14. Will I be required to submit a report?

Yes. Fellows are required to submit a brief research progress or completion report to AeU and ASAIHL Malaysia at the end of their residency.

15. Can the fellowship be extended beyond 4 weeks?

Usually it will not be extended. However, extensions may be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to AeU's approval and funding availability. However, the fellowship value remains fixed at RM7,000.
