



1. What is the AeU - ASAIHL Young Academic Fellowship (AAYAF)?

The AAYAF is an academic mobility program initiated by Asia e University (AeU) in collaboration with the Association of Southeast Asian Institutions of Higher Learning (ASAIHL). It supports young academics from ASAIHL member institutions to serve as visiting lecturers at AeU, promoting cross-border academic collaboration, professional development, and regional networking.

2. Who is eligible to apply for the AAYAF?

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an Full Time employed academic staff member from an ASAIHL member institution.
- Be below 40 years of age at the time of application.
- Demonstrate academic excellence and a commitment to international collaboration.

3. What is the duration of the fellowship?

The fellowship duration ranges from a **minimum of 2 weeks** to a **maximum of 8 weeks**. The exact period will be mutually agreed upon by the Fellow's home institution and AeU.

4. Do I need prior approval before applying?

Yes. Before submitting an application, there must be a **formal agreement** between the sending institution and AeU to ensure alignment in academic needs and expectations.

5. What support will AeU provide during the fellowship?

AeU will provide the below worth RM7500:

- A return economy-class air ticket.
- Accommodation in a **3-star hotel or equivalent**.
- Local transportation or a reasonable allowance.

6. Will I receive a salary from AeU during the fellowship?

No. The fellowship is regarded as part of the Fellow's professional service to their **home institution**. The Fellow will continue to draw their regular salary from their own institution during the fellowship period.

7. How many fellowships are available annually?

A maximum of **2 Fellowships** will be awarded annually, fully supported by AeU.

8. What are the responsibilities of the Fellow?

- Deliver lectures, workshops, or academic activities in alignment with AeU's academic needs.
- Actively engage in academic networking and collaboration.
- Submit a brief report at the end of the fellowship outlining outcomes and experiences.

9. Can I propose a specific area or subject to teach?

Yes. However, the final subject area will be determined by AeU based on its academic requirements and relevance.

10. Is medical coverage included in the fellowship?

AeU will arrange or support **affordable medical care** for the Fellow during the period of stay. Fellows are encouraged to carry personal health insurance for additional coverage if desired.

11. How can I apply?

Interested applicants should:

- 1. Discuss the opportunity with their institution and obtain internal approval.
- 2. Contact the ASAIHL Malaysia Secretariat or AeU to initiate the formal agreement.
- 3. Submit a completed application form and supporting documents after the agreement is in place.
